

ADVENT PROGRAMS

With the pandemic still raging on and the inability to have in-person programs, I want to draw your attention to some of the programs that the Servants of the Holy Heart of Mary are offering for Advent.

~ADVENT BUSY PERSON'S RETREAT: This is a prayer/reflection program for each day of Advent. Participants receive a booklet to use as a guide. You commit yourself to ½ hour of prayer each day and a weekly meeting with me or one of the SSCM spiritual directors. (This can be done by phone, Messenger, or in person meeting at the rectory-observing appropriate safety restrictions).

~ZOOM ADVENT SERIES: Each week during Advent (Saturday mornings or Monday evenings) we offer a time of reflection on each Advent Sunday's Readings. (This replaces the Advent retreat that is usually offered at One Heart, One Soul Spirituality Center in Kankakee.)
